

4. Criteria

South Australian of the Year | Arts

The Grant Burge Wines Arts category aims to celebrate the spirit of creativity exhibited by South Australian artists. The Arts Award is for arts related projects or events, individual artists or groups of artists or arts projects.

Judging Structure

- Judges are asked to score the nominee against each selection criteria point
- Scores between 1 and 10 (1=lowest, 10=highest) will be given for each selection criteria point
- The maximum score able to be given by judges for the Arts category is 150.

Arts category selection criteria:

Personal Integrity / Influence / Leadership

1. Personal, academic and professional achievements within the past 12 months
2. Demonstrated leadership, innovation and creativity
3. What achievements reflect your contribution/s to the South Australian Arts community as an inspirational role model?

Professional and Personal Contribution and Service

4. Nature of art
5. Demonstrated excellence in the Arts
6. Create work that engages with the public, immediately or in the long term
7. Embody the spirit of the Arts - the pursuit of creativity and self-expression, overcoming challenges, celebrating achievement and excellence
8. Future goals and likely impact upon whom
9. Degree of difficulty of the achievement and sacrifices made and lessons learned
10. Contribution to development of the Arts in South Australia
11. Commercial success of the nominee

Community Contribution and Service

12. Proven contribution to the South Australian community
13. Implemented policies and projects that have positively impacted on the South Australian Arts community and describe the generated outcomes and their long term benefit
14. How well have you engaged community participation and leadership?
15. Voluntary work beyond paid employment within the Arts community.
