South Australian of the Year Awards | Health

The WorkCover SA Health category recognises the work of individuals, departments and businesses who have enhanced the quality of life and wellbeing of South Australians by making a significant contribution towards South Australian health practice or policy.

Judging Structure

- Judges are asked to score the nominee against each selection criteria point
- Scores between 1 and 10 (1=lowest, 10=highest) will be given for each selection criteria point
- The maximum score able to be given by judges for the Health category is 180.

Health category selection criteria:

Personal Integrity / Influence / Leadership

1. Personal values
2. Personal, academic and professional achievements within the past 12 months
3. Demonstrated leadership, innovation and creativity
4. Experience as an inspirational role model, mentor and/or advisor for the South Australian Health community

Professional and Personal Contribution and Service

5. Demonstrated excellence in their field
6. Created public health projects or initiatives that have made a significant contribution to improving or supporting South Australians' quality of life, health and well being
7. Contributed to an increase in the knowledge base and understanding of health issues
8. Demonstrated innovation in new service or program delivery or made significant improvements to the effectiveness of existing health programs
9. Commitment to meeting public health needs
10. Professional and personal development
11. Nature and length of activity or service
12. Future goals and likely impact on the South Australian Health community/industry
13. Degree of difficulty of the achievement and sacrifices made

Community Contribution and Service

14. Proven contribution to the South Australian Health community/industry
15. Raised awareness of public health issues
16. Implemented policies and projects that positively impact health in the South Australian community and generate outcomes that have a long term benefit
17. Voluntary work beyond paid employment
18. Community participation and leadership.
