

## 4. Criteria

### South Australian of the Year Awards | Sport

*Sponsored by The South Australian Jockey Club*

The South Australian Jockey Club Sports category seeks to applaud the talents of sporting individuals, groups, teams, clubs, coaches, trainers or volunteers who have contributed towards significantly raising the profile of a particular sport in South Australia.

#### Judging Structure

- Judges are asked to score the nominee against each selection criteria point
- Scores between 1 and 10 (1=lowest, 10=highest) will be given for each selection criteria point
- The maximum score able to be given by judges for Sport category is 170.

#### Sports category selection criteria:

##### Personal Integrity / Influence / Leadership

1. Personal values
2. Displayed the qualities of sportsmanship and a sense of fair play
3. Personal, academic and professional achievements within the past 12 months
4. Achievement of personal sporting or physical activity goals and objectives, or positively contributing to an athlete's, sporting team's or club's goals and objectives
5. Demonstrated leadership, innovation and creativity
6. Experience as an inspirational role model, mentor and/or advisor for the South Australian Sporting community

##### Professional and Personal Contribution and Service

7. Achieved sporting excellence at a local, state, national or international level
8. Embodies the spirit of sport - the pursuit of excellence, overcoming challenges, celebrating achievement and excellence and winning against the odds
9. Contribution towards improving the quality of life for others (for example, fulfilling a mentoring role for a young person or people)
10. Commitment to sporting and physical activities that have short and long term benefits to others in the community (for example, coaching, mentoring or managing a sporting team)
11. Nature and length of activity or service
12. Future goals and likely impact on the South Australian Sporting community
13. Degree of difficulty of the achievement and sacrifices made

##### Community Contribution and Service

14. Proven contribution to the South Australian sporting community
15. Implemented policies and projects that positively impact on the South Australian sporting community and generate outcomes that have a long term benefit
16. Voluntary work beyond paid employment
17. Community participation and leadership.
