South Australian of the Year Awards | Community

The Mitsubishi Motors Australia Limited Community category aims to acknowledge the outstanding contributions of individuals, not for profit organisations, volunteer groups and/or community groups who work tirelessly on community based projects and events and who have made outstanding contributions to their local community.

Judging Structure

- Judges are asked to score the nominee against each selection criteria point
- Scores between 1 and 10 (1=lowest, 10=highest) will be given for each selection criteria point
- The maximum score able to be given by judges for the Community category is 190.

Community category selection criteria:

Personal Integrity / Influence / Leadership

(Each selection criteria point in this section will be scored out of 10)

1. Personal values
2. Personal, academic and professional achievements within the past 12 months
3. Demonstrated leadership, innovation and creativity
4. Experience as an inspirational role model, mentor and/or advisor for the South Australian community

Professional and Personal Contribution and Service

(Each selection criteria point in this section will be scored out of 10)

5. Demonstrated excellence in their field by making a significant difference to the lives of other people
6. Demonstrated involvement in the development of the South Australian community
7. Demonstrated far reaching impact or the potential for impact
8. Demonstrated service over and above the call of duty
9. Professional and personal development
10. A quiet achiever demonstrating best intent
11. Nature and length of activity or service within the South Australian community
12. Future goals and likely impact on the South Australian community
13. Degree of difficulty of the achievement and sacrifices made

Community Contribution and Service

(Each selection criteria point in this section will be scored out of 20)

14. Proven contribution to the South Australian community
15. Implemented policies and projects that positively impact on the South Australian community and generate outcomes that have a long term benefit
16. Voluntary work beyond paid employment.
